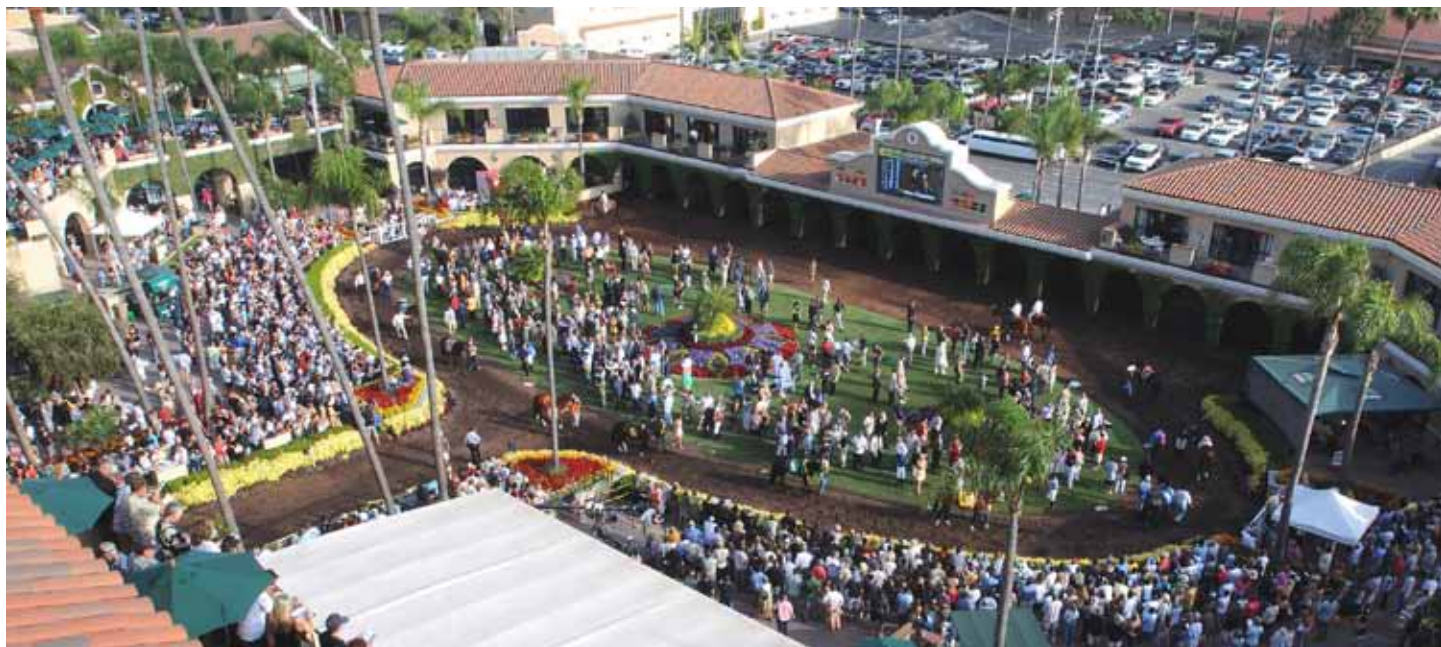


# 2011 Del Mar Thoroughbred Club Horsemen's Guide

Welcome to our 72nd season of racing. The Del Mar Thoroughbred Club appreciates your hard work and dedication to Thoroughbred racing. We realize the vital role you play in making Del Mar one of the most successful race meets in the country. We hope we can make this an enjoyable and successful summer for you!

Del Mar is offering the most prestigious stakes schedule ever with 31 major stake races worth just over \$7 million. The track's signature event, the \$1-million TVG Pacific Classic will be run for the 21st time on Sunday, August 28. The \$1-Million TVG Pacific Classic, is also the most lucrative race of the expanded Breeders' Cup Challenge program. Other races include, the \$125,000 Cougar II, the \$300,000 Clement L. Hirsch Handicap, the \$200,000 San Diego Handicap, the \$200,000 Del Mar Handicap and the \$250,000 Del Mar Futurity. The winner of these stakes races automatically get a starting spot in their corresponding race, and travel and entry fees paid at this year's Breeder's Cup Championship.

If the horse is in the money, you will also receive a bonus payment of 20% of what ever purse money that horse earns in its first start.

Located on the 5th floor, you will be escorted up to our seaside view, bar where you can toast your big win with a bottle of Chandon Champagne. Your race will be re-played over and over while you celebrate your victory.

Four O'Clock Fridays will return, featuring concerts in our new Seaside Stage located west of the Grandstand following the races. Family Fun Weekends will return every Saturday and Sunday in the Infield. We are also hosting our first annual Gourmet Food Truck Festival.

## Ben Harper and Beer Fest

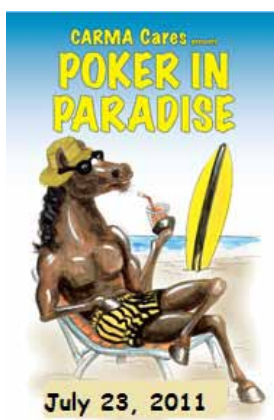

Six of Del Mar's 2011 summer stake races have been designated Breeders' Cup Challenge races. The expanded series will be hosted at premier race tracks around the world. Heading the list at Del Mar is the \$1 million TVG Pacific Classic. Del Mar will also host The Cougar Handicap, San Diego Handicap, Clement L. Hirsch Handicap Del Mar Handicap and Del Mar Futurity as Breeders' Cup Challenge races. The winner of these races earn automatic starting spot, and travel and entry fees are paid into the World Championships.

## California Horse Racing Board ("CHRB")

### Licensing

The California Horse Racing Board licensing office can be reached by entering the main stable gate at the corner of Jimmy Durante Blvd. and Via de la Valle. It is located in the strip of office buildings immediately to the south of the stable area entrance.

License applications, renewals and validations are processed from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Wednesday through Sunday during the race meet.

Trainers are responsible for ensuring that all their employees hold valid CHRB licenses. All employees must be on a trainer's work list.

### Insurance

The CHRB requires a certificate of insurance verifying proper coverage. It does not accept telegrams or verbal contacts. The following codes must be present on all CHRB insurance policies: Racing Operations Insurance Code 8631 and Jockey's Insurance Code 8278. Complete information regarding insurance requirements is available at the CHRB office at 858-755-1141, Ext. 3885.

Horsemen shipping from out-of-state are advised to bring workers' compensation documents for filing with the CHRB, as well as Lasix/Official Bleeders Certificates, current Coggins tests and Foal Certificate papers. Out-of-state policies must state "covers all racing operations in California" to be accepted.

### Anabolic Steroids Prohibition

The CHRB prohibits all anabolic steroids except as provided in Rule 1844(e). The complete text of Rule 1844

is available on the CHRB web site ([www.chrb.ca.gov](http://www.chrb.ca.gov)). All anabolic steroids are Class 3 violations and Category B penalties with the exception of boldenone (Equipoise®), nandrolone (Durabolin®), stanozolol (Winstrol®) and testosterone which are Class 4 violations and Category D penalties. Class 3 violations require purse redistribution and a minimum 30 day suspension and \$500 fine absent mitigating and aggravating factors. Class 4 violations call for an official warning which may be placed on the trainer's record.

Horses nominated for stakes in California or otherwise intending to race in California may be eligible for pre-entry urine testing for anabolic steroids. Specific eligibility information is available at [www.chrb.ca.gov](http://www.chrb.ca.gov), from the official veterinarian at Del Mar or the CHRB's Equine Medical Director (Dr\_Arthur@chrb.ca.gov).

Located in the backside Racing Office, the Clerk of the Course provides required validation of owners' licenses for use at the current meeting as well as admission credentials and parking stickers. Sandy King in the frontside Racing Office can also assist owners with admission credentials, parking and validation stickers.

## Horsemen's Bookkeeper (Paymaster of Purses)

On most race days the Paymaster's Office is open from 10:00 a.m. until 30 minutes after the last race. On Fridays, the office is open from noon until 30 minutes after the last race. The Paymaster's Office is adjacent to the frontside Racing Office. If calling after hours, please leave a voice mail message at 858-794-1034.

No purse money will be available until cleared by the California Horse Racing Board 48 hours after a race has run.

Owners and trainers are required to deposit jockey fees before a horse starts.

### Wiring Instructions

Horsemen are able to wire money to their account at the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club via Bank of America San Diego Commercial Banking #1450, 450 B Street, San Diego, CA 92101. Be sure to reference ABA 026009593, credit to Del Mar Race Meeting Trust Account # 1459473815, Attention Paymaster's Office and include the Horsemen's account name the money is being wired to.

### Claiming Requirements

When claiming a horse, the cleared funds plus San Diego County sales tax (7.75%) must be on account with the Paymaster prior to filing the claim. Cleared funds can be in the form of a cashier's check, cash, cleared purse earnings, checks from other well-known California Racing Associations or wire transfers.

## Horsemen's Organizations/Backside Services

Services at Del Mar for backstretch employees include:

### California Thoroughbred Horsemen's Foundation, Inc.

The CTHF is a nonprofit health and welfare organization established to assist Thoroughbred horsemen in

### **California Thoroughbred Trainers (CTT)**

The CTT office at Del Mar is located near the main stable gate. If you have questions or problems regarding track safety, stable area repairs, recreation hall or recreational activities for backstretch workers, visit their office Monday, 9:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m.; Tuesday, 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. and Wednesday, 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. You may also reach the CTT/CTHF office by calling 858-792-4488 in Del Mar or by contacting Angie Carmona at the Santa Anita Office at 626-447-2145.

### **Winners Foundation**

The Winners Foundation maintains an office in Del Mar to help any employees or their family members who may be having problems with alcohol and/or drugs. They offer support plans, all free of charge. Winners Foundation is a voluntary program and confidentiality is assured. The office is located at the main stable gate. Contact Robert Fletcher or LeRoy Martinez at 858-792-4416.

## **Horsemen's Lounge**

The Horsemen's Lounge, open to all owners and trainers with a valid CHRB license, is located on the third floor of the Stretch Run. The air-conditioned lounge features its own mutuel windows, bar service (food service can be ordered through the bartender), a covered patio overlooking the paddock, numerous monitors, big-screen TV, conference area and facilities for faxing or copying documents.

Horsemen are permitted four guests each and only two guests on Opening Day and Pacific Classic. Please, no unescorted children. Sheila McDonnell, the Horsemen's Lounge Concierge 858-792-4243, is available for assistance with area restaurant and hotel reservations. Horsemen with horses running that day may also pick up complimentary programs in the lounge on a first-come, first-served basis.

## **Horsemen's Services**

Horsemen are encouraged to utilize our Horsemen's Services Department by contacting Lisa Iaria (Director of Horsemen's Services), Sheila McDonnell (Horsemen's Lounge Concierge) and Sandy King (Secretary to the Vice President, Racing). Lisa can be reached at 858-794-1040 or by cellular at 619-261-8301, Sheila at 858-792-4243 (afternoons) and Sandy at 858-792-4230. George Bradvica, Manager of Surfside Race Place at 858-750-0492, will also be in the barn area in the mornings to assist horsemen with questions.

The Horsemen's Services staff is available to assist with any questions you may have and with all on-track arrangements such as admission, seating and dining, as well as hotel, rental and restaurant reservations. The Horsemen's Services office is located in Caballo Hall, directly across the walkway from the Frontside Racing Office.

## **Invitations for Stakes Lunch**

Owners and trainers of scheduled and overnight stakes race entries are invited to be the track's guests for lunch that day in the Directors' Room. Please contact Lisa Iaria as soon as your stakes horse is entered. (Please note: On Opening Day, seating in the Directors' Room is extremely limited.)

### **Seating for Races**

Owners and trainers are offered limited track seating on the days they have runners. A limited number of tables are set aside daily for horsemen in the Clubhouse Terrace Restaurant overlooking the track. Clubhouse Terrace Restaurant tables can be reserved through Lisa Iaria or Sandy King. (Please note: Preference for these tables is ALWAYS given to horsemen with runners entered on that day.) Box seats, including some with beverage service, can be arranged through Sandy King. Turf Club dining is available for Turf Club members only and must be arranged through the Turf Club. Any Turf Club nonmember seeking Turf Club arrangements must contact Tom Robbins, Senior Vice President, Racing at 858-792-4230.

Other available dining facilities include the Veranda Cafe on the second floor of the Clubhouse overlooking the paddock (on a first-come, first-served basis); the Café del Sol located trackside below the Clubhouse Terrace Restaurant; the Charlie Whittingham Sports Pub; O'Brien's Pub, overlooking the paddock from the Stretch Run side; the Stretch Run Grill located trackside in the Stretch Run area; and Il Palio Restaurant on the sixth floor (call Lisa Iaria for reservations, when available, in Il Palio).

Fifth floor Luxury Suites and sixth floor Skyrooms occasionally are available for daily rental on a very limited basis. Please check with Lisa Iaria for details.
