‘Ship and Win’ Program for Bringing Horses to Del Mar from Out of State

RULES AND ELIGIBILITY FOR “QUALIFIED” STARTERS

- A guaranteed \$1,000 bonus for any starter in its initial Del Mar race (**Stakes races included**) whose previous start was made outside California. Horses that raced in California for the same owner or ownership group in the previous six (6) months are not eligible.
- Further, there will be an additional 33 1/3% bonus applied to a horse’s purse earnings in its initial Del Mar race (**Stakes races excluded**) whose previous start was made outside California. Horses that raced in California for the same owner or ownership group in the previous six (6) months are not eligible.
- Both the \$1,000 bonus and the 33 1/3% purse bonus apply only to each horse’s first race at Del Mar, not subsequent starts.
- DMTC reserves the right to determine eligibility for qualified starters.



Notice: CHRB Medication Rules

Clenbuterol

Effective July 18, 2012 the authorization for a threshold level for clenbuterol as currently allowed under CHRB 1844 (e)(9) and 1844(f) was suspended for all breeds at all race tracks in California. Accordingly, clenbuterol is treated as other drugs not specifically authorized by the Board: If the lab detects clenbuterol under laboratory's standard operating procedures, the finding will be reported as a violation. The Maddy lab has very sensitive testing for clenbuterol. The drug can be readily detected at low picogram levels in both urine and blood. The CHRB recommends a 21 day withdrawal time provided the clenbuterol is the FDA approved Ventipulmin form of clenbuterol used at the standard therapeutic 5cc twice a day dose (0.8 micrograms per kilogram twice a day). Higher dosages will require longer withdrawal times.

Phenylbutazone and Flunixin

The CHRB has changed the levels permitted for phenylbutazone and flunixin under Rule 1844 (c) effective March 17th, 2012. The permitted threshold for phenylbutazone is 2 micrograms/ml of plasma and the permitted levels for flunixin is 20 nanograms/ml of plasma.

Notice: Anabolic Steroids

The CHRB prohibits all anabolic steroids except as provided in Rule 1844(e). The complete text of Rule 1844 is available on the CHRB website (www.chrb.ca.gov). Horses nominated for stakes in California or otherwise intending to race in California may be eligible for pre-entry urine testing for anabolic steroids. DEL MAR TO HOST FIVE BREEDERS' CUP CHALLENGE RACES AS PART OF 2013 SCHEDULE



The Breeders' Cup Challenge Series will consist of 65 automatic qualifying races into the Breeders' Cup World Championships. This year's series will be conducted in ten countries. Del Mar will host five races during the 2013 Breeders' Cup Challenge Series beginning on July 28 with the Bing Crosby Stakes.

Among the highlights of this year's series are:

- As part of the enhanced benefits program for Breeders' Cup Challenge winners, the Breeders' Cup will pay the entry fees* for the winner of all Challenge races starting in the Championships. For this year's World Championships, Breeders' Cup will also provide a travel allowance for all participants shipping from outside North America of \$40,000. Owners of domestic horses shipping to California within North America will receive a \$10,000 travel allowance. The Challenge winner must be nominated to the Breeders' Cup program by the Championship's pre-entry deadline of October 21, 2013 to receive the rewards. In addition, the Breeders' Cup is reducing its entry fees for its Championship races from 3% to 2%.


The Paddock Sale at Del Mar

- Current Coggins Test
- California Workers’ Compensation
- Foal Certificate Papers
