UNBRIDLED, devoid of early speed, rallied but could not gain the needed ground in the drive. FESTIN-AR, far back while last early, raced wide down the backstretch, also rallied but could not gain the needed ground in the drive. FARMA WAY established the early pace without being hustled, yielded the lead to TWILIGHT AGENDA a little more than a quarter of a mile out and weakened in the drive. ITSALLGREEKTOME, able to save ground along the inside rail through the early stages, was outrun early but not far back and lacked the necessary response in the final quarter. ANSHAN-GB, close up through the early stages, faltered and was four wide into the stretch. STALWART CHARGER, close up to the far turn, stopped.
