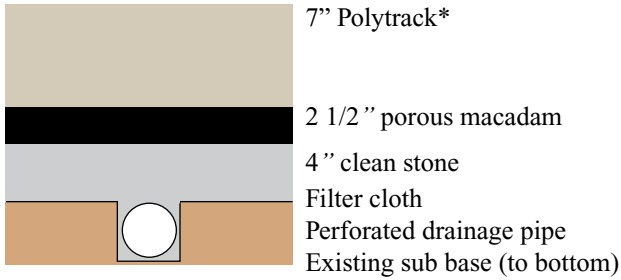


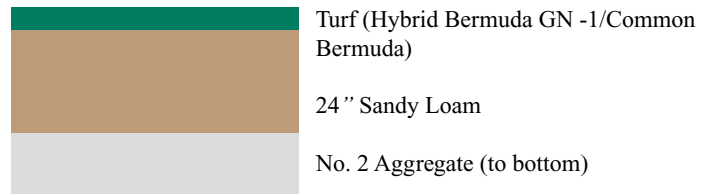
Del Mar Main Track and Turf Course

Track Composition

TURF COURSE



*Polytrack is an engineered racetrack system combining a top layer — comprised of silica sand, recycled rubber, fibers and wax — that provides a soft cushion for horse and rider above a vertical drainage structure that allows for rapid dispersal of water, thus ensuring a continuously safe and stable racing surface.

Track Specifications

MAIN TRACK

One-mile oval with chutes for 7/8 and 1 1/4-mile races
Track is 77 feet wide through the stretch
Distance from last turn to finish line: 919 feet

TURF COURSE

Seven-eighths mile oval with a diagonal straightaway chute for 1 1/16 and 1 1/8 mile races.
Turf: A mixture of Common Bermuda and Hybrid Bermuda (GN-1)
Course is 63 feet wide through the stretch
Distance from last turn to finish line: 761 feet

One Mile: 220 ft.
All Other Distances 45 ft.
