## General Information

**Location**—In the City of Del Mar, California, on the 350-acre Del Mar Fairgrounds 20 miles north of San Diego and 100 miles south of Los Angeles, next to Interstate 5, just a “good chip shot from the Pacific Ocean.”

**Climate**—Ideal in every aspect, comfortably balmy and in the hub of one of California’s most popular summer resort areas.

**Accessibility**—North and south approaches are via Interstate 5 freeway. From the northeast, via Interstate 15. From the east via Hwys. 78 and 56. Scheduled airline service to San Diego International Airport. Amtrak and Coaster trains to Solana Beach Station. (Free shuttle buses meet all trains.)

**Seating Capacity**—14,304. Stretch Run—8,755; Clubhouse—2,655; Turf Club—2,344; Skyrooms, 550.

**Parking**—Space for 10,000 cars. General parking \$8; Valet \$20; Early Bird \$8.

**Admission Prices**—Stretch Run and infield admission, \$6 (Opening Day

\$10). Active duty military free any day with I.D. Children 17 and under admitted free; must be accompanied by parent or guardian. Clubhouse admission, \$10 (Opening Day \$20). Reserved seats \$5 – Wednesday, Thursday; \$8 – Friday; \$10 – Saturday, Sunday & Labor Day; \$15 – Opening Day/Pacific Classic Day. Free official program (\$2 value) included with all admissions.

**PostTime**—2:00 p.m. daily with the following exceptions: “Three O’Clock Fridays” 3:00 p.m. all Fridays; 1:00 p.m. Pacific Classic Day, Sunday, Sept. 6. Racing five days per week, Wednesday through Sunday, closed Monday and Tuesday, with the exception of Labor Day.

**Stable Area Capacity**—Stalls for 2,100 Thoroughbreds, plus feed rooms, tack rooms and living quarters.

**Security**—Security Office located in Mission Tower building adjacent to far western end of the grandstand. Lost and Found Department located in same office.

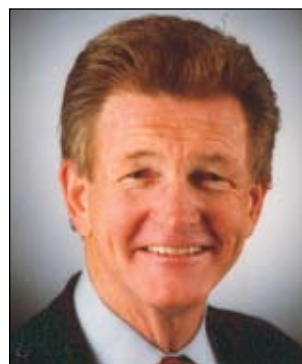

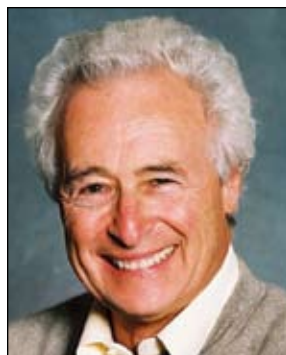
**TOM C. STICKEL, Director**

Owns River Edge Farm in Buellton, California, as well as more than 70 broodmares and about 40 horses in training... Breeder/owner of 2-year-old juvenile filly champion Sweet Catomine—2004 Breeders' Cup and Eclipse Award winner... Leading California breeder in 2006 and 2007... Past trainer the late V.J. (Lefty) Nickerson; current trainers Dan Hendricks, Bill Mott, John Shirreffs and Clifford Sise, Jr.



**BETTY L. MABEE, Director Emeritus**

Betty, with her late husband John, purchased two Cal-bred yearlings at the Del Mar sale in 1957, the starting point for their remarkable run in the Thoroughbred industry... Together they built one of the west's premier breeding and racing establishments – Golden Eagle Farm – which in turn produced more than 200 stakes winners and thousands of racehorses while earning the Mabees three Eclipse Awards as the nation's top breeders... Betty carries on the farm's name and work with extensive help from her son Larry... John, who died in 2002, was one of the founders of Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, a founding director of Breeders' Cup Ltd. and a member of The Jockey Club... Betty previously served as a director of the California Thoroughbred Breeders Association and is only the second woman to sit on the DMTC board, a role she took up in 2002... She founded several notable charity organizations in the San Diego area and sat on the boards of dozens of others... She began her current role of Director Emeritus in 2008.
