71st Running Of California Thoroughbred Breeders Association Stakes \$100,000 Guaranteed (Includes \$25,000 from the Cal-Bred Race Fund)

FOR GOLDEN STATE SERIES ELIGIBLE CALIFORNIA BRED OR CALIFORNIA SIREB FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$1,000 each (non-Golden State Series eligible horses, \$25,000 to supplement -- which will make that horse eligible to all future Golden State Series Stakes) by closing time of entries. All horses to pay \$1,500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed, of which \$57,000 to first, \$19,000 to second, \$12,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$4,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Weight 122 lbs.; Non-winners of two races other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 4 lbs. High weights preferred. Total earnings in non-claiming races will be used in determining the preference of horses with equal weights. STARTERS TO BE NAMED THROUGH THE ENTRY BOX THURSDAY, AUGUST 1, BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.
